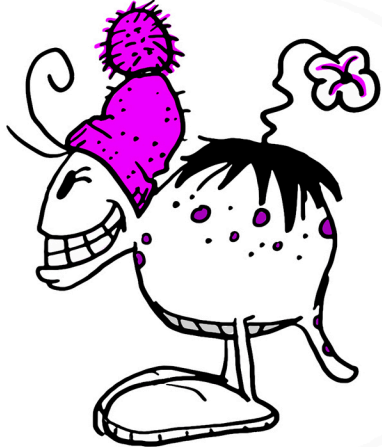


# Linaloomp

Put on your friendship hat and find out.

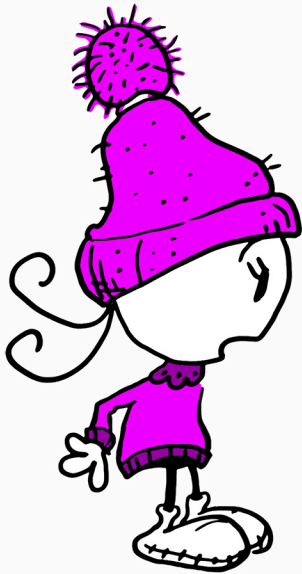

which for me would be just fine.



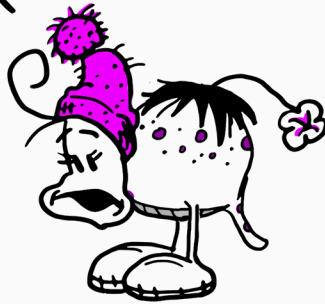


she smiled a little and said hello.

intentions.



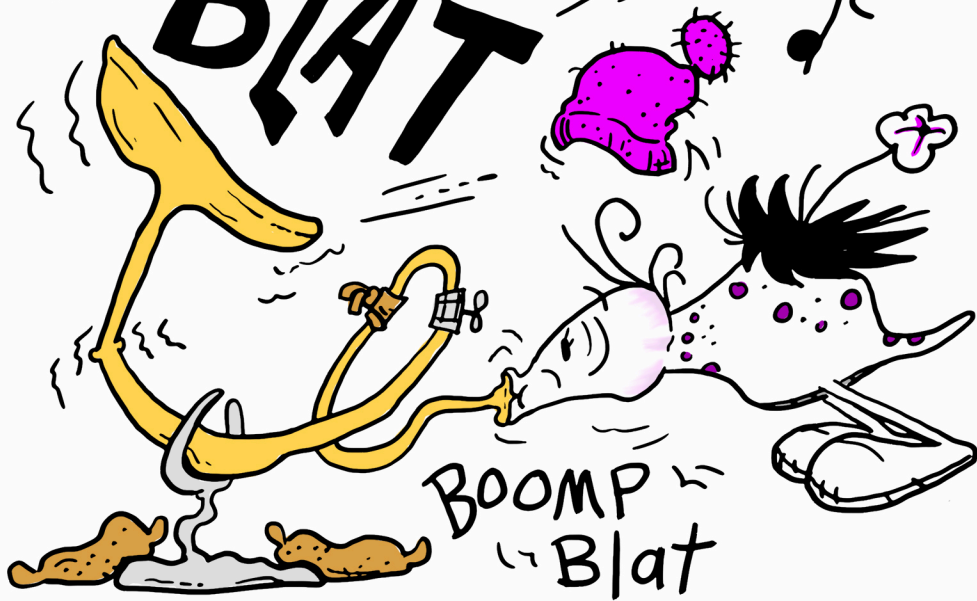
FRIENDSHIP,

LoompioBLAT.

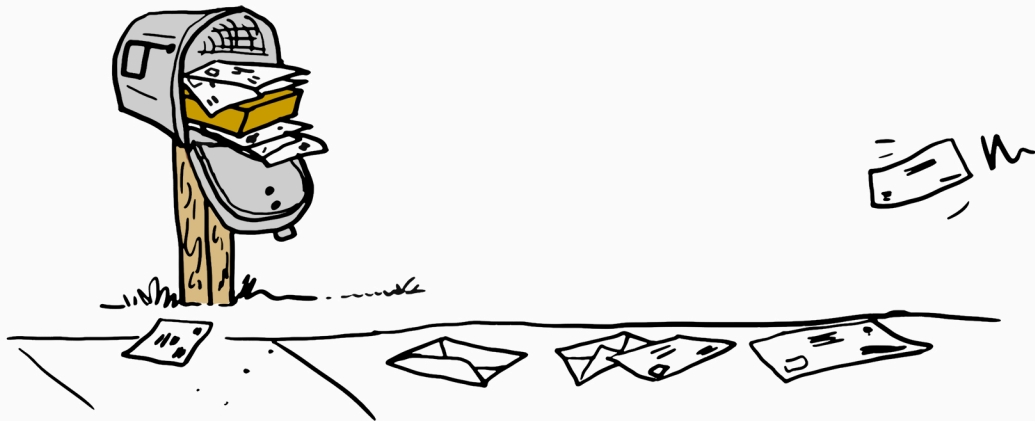

the lettering trail.



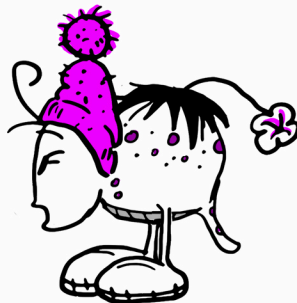
THAT'S OK...WE WON'T GIVE UP!

HIM ANOTHER TIME.

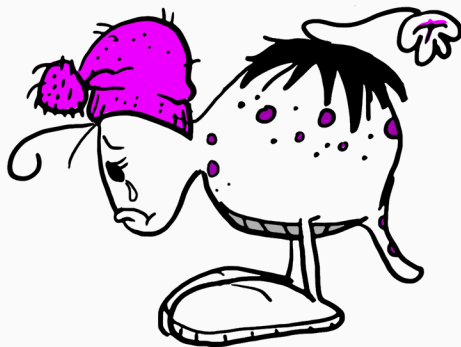


HE LIKES CREATING VIDEO GAMES...  
AND HE ALSO LIKES TO RHYME.

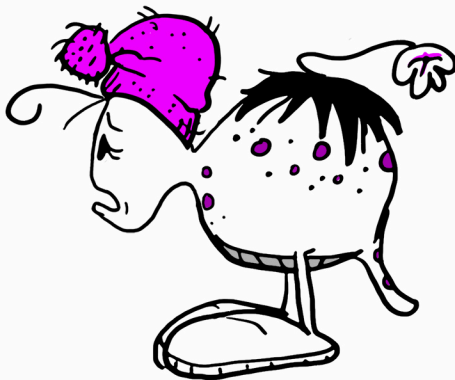




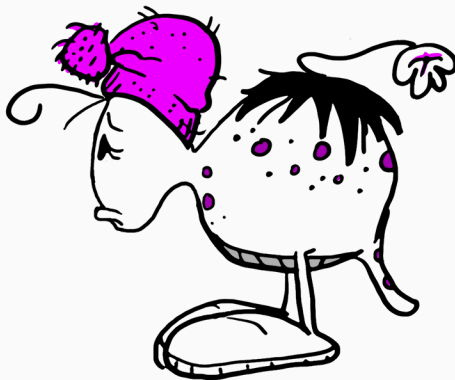
EVERYONE'S BUSY OR NOT AROUND.

THAT'S WHAT FRIENDS ARE FOR.







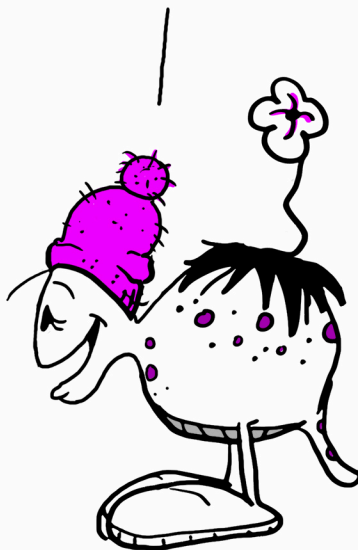
DOES THIS MAKE
